Dear New Maloney Band Member:

I would like to start by welcoming you to Francis T. Maloney High School and the Instrumental Music Department. Comprised of over 100 musicians, the band program is one of the biggest and most active groups within the school. You are about to join an exciting group that will be an integral part of your high school career. From marching band to concert band to colorguard to jazz to musicals, there is something for everyone to get involved in. I hope you are as excited to join us as we are to have you!

The following is some basic information regarding the band and what we have in store for you this summer and fall. Please take careful note of it and get back to me with any questions you may have. And remember...if you are nervous, worried or not sure about this whole high school band thing...it is the same way everyone feels at the beginning. Don't worry, after the first day of camp you will have a whole new outlook on high school band!

Band Camp:

Camp is a mandatory function of the Maloney Band Program. It is a two-week summer training program designed to begin the fall marching band program and prepare all members for the upcoming year. All members must attend. Conflicts must be discussed with the director by a parent prior to June 30th. Attendance is taken at every day of camp. Like all performances and rehearsals, camp is a graded part of the course.

For band camp you must bring your instrument and yourself, and you must learn the music provided to the best of your ability. We have some other things you will need, such as a flip-book and a lyre, but everything you need will be ready for you when you get to camp.

Each day requires a lot of physical activity. Please wear light clothes, shorts, socks and sneakers (NO FLIP FLOPS) and bring a water jug (not a little water bottle... a jug that can keep a good amount of water cold – like the one pictured below). Please be sure to eat a good breakfast before each session even if you are not accustomed to eating breakfast. Be sure to wear sunscreen every day and bring some with you to reapply. We are outside a lot and much of the day is spent in the sun.



Camp will take place at Maloney High School.

Music:

If you are wind player, music will be provided to you prior to the end of the school year. If you are a percussionist or colorguard member, you will get everything you need at summer sessions and camp. Email me if you have any questions at brian.cyr@meridenk12.org
