- Department Trip
 - Disney 3/27-3/30 - 4 day trip (return flight is late-late)
 - Airline: Jet Blue
 - Departing from LaGuardia / return is JFK.
 - School work while students are away – students are responsible to complete any assignments for classes they’ll miss. Time is available during the trip for homework.
 - Performance/park details not available yet; itinerary TBD
 - Initial deposits (\$250) and parent permission in family ID due this week
 - \$1350 total cost – working on fundraisers to defray costs
 - Payment plan in charms – not systematically scheduled; department determined payment. Plan (9/27, 10/25, 11/22, 1/17, 2/14) - \$250 due each installment; final payment/balance due by 2/14.
 - Charms ap wont’ allow credit card payment; will need to go to website if using credit/debit. Cash/Checks always accepted. Cyr has square card reader in office if needed.
 - Program ads/finances added to charms today. If family does not see fundraising credits, contact Cyr/Pelletier/Cohen.
 - The trips aren’t refundable. Trip insurance available via Family ID (at family discretion)
 - Included in trip:

 - Ground transportation for whole trip
 - Breakfasts
 - Food voucher for 1 other meal/day

- If extra seats available from block of seats Maloney reserved (on plane) – parents will have first option to purchase those. Otherwise, parents are welcome to purchase their own flight tickets at a time convenient for them.
